

Eau Gallie Arts District (EGAD), City of Melbourne

Background: One of the CME's goals speaks to community engagement and enhancing the appreciation and understanding for the cultural and natural diversity the Lagoon has to offer. In support of this program, the CME developed a program designed to place informational kiosks at key locations along the Byway. In 2014, the Eau Gallie Arts District, located in the City of Melbourne, donated time, location, and funding to the installation of an informational kiosk along the Byway. This kiosk not only tells the story of the Indian River Lagoon, but of the intrinsic qualities that these places have to offer. This kiosk was installed at Pineapple Park in November 2014. The local community celebrated the ribbon cutting of this kiosk, and the progress with which the IRLNSB Coalition has made with promoting the Byway's mission.

Current Status: The kiosk has been constructed.

Cost: \$2000 was donated by the Eau Gallie Arts District for the installation of this kiosk
